

How to determine your WAC ASN in 3 Easy Steps!

Note: Do NOT use a serial number generator—none of them give an accurate WAC ASN

1. Determine if your impression is enlisted, warrant officer or officer
 - a. Enlisted: Prefix is A-
 - b. Warrant Officer: Prefix is V-
 - c. Officer: Prefix is L-

2. Determine state of enlistment. The first number after the prefix indicates the service command of your induction center.
 - a. 1 = First Service Command
 - Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Vermont
 - b. 2 = Second Service Command
 - Delaware, New Jersey, New York
 - c. 3 = Third Service Command
 - Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia
 - d. 4 = Fourth Service Command
 - Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee
 - e. 5 = Fifth Service Command
 - Indiana, Kentucky, Ohio, West Virginia
 - f. 6 = Sixth Service Command
 - Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin
 - g. 7 = Seventh Service Command
 - Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming
 - h. 8 = Eighth Service Command
 - Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas
 - i. 9 = Ninth Service Command
 - Alaska, Arizona, California, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington

3. Choose 5 more digits & you are done!

Examples:

ASN	L-500001
Name	Charity E. Adams
State of residence	South Carolina
Place of enlistment	Ft. Hayes, Columbus

ASN	A-306397
Name	Alta Zimmerman
State of residence	Pennsylvania
State of enlistment	Harrisburg, Pennsylvania
